READING CLUB

For students reading on their own

Ages 6-13

Runs through Thursday, August 12

Registration starts Monday, June 14

Recording/reporting books starts Monday, June 21



Keep track of how many minutes a day you read, then come in and stamp your way along your personal "Make a Splash" reading chart (designed by Conestoga student Kyle Donahue) as you progress. Custom-designed tee shirts will be earned by all who reach *five hours* of reading, and one sweepstakes prize ticket will be earned for *each additional hour* of reading after that. The more hours you read, the better chance you have to win a sweepstakes prize!

For optimum service at the Reading Club table, please arrive at the library at least 20 minutes prior to closing.

READ-TO-ME CLUB

For children not yet reading independently

Ages 3-6

Runs through Thursday, August 12

Registration starts Monday, June 14

Recording/reporting books starts Monday, June 21



Read books to your child at home and then come in once a week to have your child add his/her favorite to the chart and receive a prize. Your weekly visit *to add your book and get your prize* may be done any time during library hours.

However, specific times (TBA) to have your child *talk about his/her book with a staff member or volunteer* at the Reading Club table will also occur at various points during the week. The schedule of specific reporting times will be posted once our volunteers have finalized their schedules.
