TAX FORMS AND TAX PREP ASSISTANCE

Federal and state tax forms for 2011 will be available at Tredyffrin library beginning 01/16/2012. While some materials may not arrive until early February, we will present all forms and booklets as they become available.

Tax Season Tips:

The deadline to file your taxes this year is April 17, pushed back two days because of the weekend. If you can't make this deadline, you can request an extension (use form 4868) and file later, but if you owe money, you still need to pay by April 17th .

The IRS makes it easy to file your taxes online with the e-file system (www.irs.gov/efile/index.html). Online filing is free, reduces the risk of making a mistake and lets you get your refund more quickly.

If you would rather submit a paper return, you can get forms here at Tredyffrin Library or download them from the IRS at www.irs.gov/formspubs/index.html

Once you've filed your taxes, you can track your refund status easily to find out when you'll get your money. If you e-filed you will be able to get your refund information 72 hours after the IRS receives your information. If you filed a paper return, you can check your refund status in three to four weeks. Go to www.irs.gov.

You can also check the status of your refund using IRS2GO (<http://apps.usa.gov/irs2go/>), a mobile app available for iPhone and Android devices.
