Library Director's Report to Tredyffrin Libraries Board of Trustees for January 25, 2017

Volunteers

Volunteers aid us with daily library operations and services and enable us to continue to provide exemplary service to our community. We are extremely grateful for their hard work and commitment. Comparing January – December 2016 to January – December 2017, total volunteers increased by 85 (17.9% more total volunteers) and total volunteer contributed hours increased by 542.25 (12.2% more volunteer contributed hours).

Building and Facilities

LED Lighting Project

To date, about half of the new LED fixtures have been installed in the Children's Department. I am awaiting a call from the installer to schedule dates for the remainder of the installation.

Stucco Repair

The Assistant Township Manager, Director of Finance, and I reviewed the building plans with an architect and it was recommended that the block in the wall be checked for deterioration prior to fixing the stucco. The Township's Public Works Department has excavated behind the wall and determined that the block is intact. Moving forward, the rear of the wall will be excavated, filled with stone, drainage pipes will be checked and replaced if needed, the flagstone capping will be replaced and sealed, and the stucco will be repaired. Public Works is obtaining additional quotes for the stucco wall repair.

Visitor Count and Circulation

Visitor count for December 2017 totaled 15,696. This is a decrease of 2,776 (15%) compared to November 2017 and a decrease of 1.045 (6.2%) compared to December 2016. However, comparing total visits in 2016 to total visits in 2017, an overall increase of 4,407 (1.9%) was recorded.

Circulation for December 2017 totaled 23,776 for print materials and 2,936 for e-materials. This is a decrease of 2,154 (8%) in borrowing of print materials and an increase of 142 (5.1%) in borrowing of electronic materials (eBooks) compared to the previous month. Comparing all checkouts from 2016 to all checkouts from 2017, total circulation of library materials increased by 944 (.3%).

Programming

The 2017 statistics for programming were found to have errors that resulted in under-reporting of actual program offerings and attendance for adult programming. The monthly recorded results were re-checked against the original written records and verified and corrected. The following chart contains the monthly adjusted totals for 2017 reflecting accurate programming counts. The number of programs for December 2017 totaled 121 and attendees totaled 1,505. Comparing total program offerings and attendance data from 2016 to 2017, there was an overall increase of 152 (12.3%) in total program offerings and an increase of 1,004 (4.4%) in total program attendees.

Looking back we had a very successful 2017 with a diverse collection of educational, fun and interactive programs. Our focus this past year has been to offer STEAM inspired programs and fill in the gaps for services and resources that local school districts do not provide. We offered a Back to Basics series where we highlighted skills such as cooking and sewing that many children ages 8-12 had not had hands-on experience with. We also focused on getting young children ready for school and our preschool storytimes have continued to be well attended. We have partnered with Lingo Language Learning in Wayne to offer Bilingual Spanish Storytimes to preschool families with great success.

Teen Notes (Submitted by Laura Doan)

Students from Katherine Mallon-Day Voice Studio held a Duet-a-Thon for the library. It was a great opportunity for friends and neighbors to experience quality music in our own Strafford Park. No need to pay for parking, take the train, or purchase tickets!

Another wonderful music event was the Sound of the Season with Surrey concert which the teen department is happy to help host annually. Anne Sprissler, who directs the Surrey Chime Choir, has been a dedicated supporter of the teen program at the library for many years.

We also held our monthly journaling workshops, coding club, book club, a Compositions for a Cause concert, A Junior Classical League Saturnalia event, rehearsals for The Little Match Girl, and our annual Reunion Dinner for college students.

The Teen Advisory Board met to plan for the Winter Ball Semi-Formal on February 9th.

Reference (Submitted by Kate Boyle)

We are excited that part-time reference librarian Jonathan Trice is going to be hosting TPL's newest book club in 2018. The Mixed Media Book Club will look at a book and a film adaptation tied to that book each month. The first selection for Sunday, January 28 is Neil Gaiman's Stardust. Jonathan is also putting together film viewings and other programs with arts & culture as a theme.

Katie Yu will be leaving the library as of Friday, January 19. We wish her well as she begins a new exciting chapter outside of libraries.

The reference department in partnership with Chester County Library System's Electronic Resource Committee will be highlighting a database each month. January is Learning Express Library where patrons can take practice tests and study to advance their schooling and/or careers.

Information transactions for 2017 increased by 2,211 (8%) compared to 2016. Computer use shows a decrease of 10,834 (24%), however, the computer use data for 2017 is being compared to the 2016 data which was collected prior to the Libraries installing software to track usage (previous usage was recorded by headcount) which has resulted in a discrepancy in comparing the data between the two years. Beginning in 2018, we will be comparing use data against 2017, which does use the software to track usage, and will result in a more accurate representation of actual desktop use in the Libraries. Information literacy sessions (1 on 1 instruction) for 2017 increased by 83 (22%) compared to 2016 and proctoring sessions increased by 53 (48%). Website usage continues to decline and we will be looking in to ways to increase our online presence in 2018.
