

# Library Director's Report to Tredyffrin Libraries Board of Trustees for May 24, 2018

## Volunteers

Volunteers aid us with daily library operations and services and enable us to continue to provide exemplary service to our community. We are extremely grateful for their hard work and commitment. Comparing April to March 2018, total volunteers increased by 4 (+9.1%) and total volunteer contributed hours decreased by 31.5 (-7.4%). Comparing 2018 totals to 2017 totals from the same time period, total volunteers increased by 28(+19.2%) and total volunteer contributed hours increased by 223.5 (+17.3%).

## **Roof Painting**

With the aid of Tredyffrin Township Public Works I received quotes to repaint the metal building façade on the roof. I am reviewing the quotes. The estimated expense is just under \$10,000.

## **Visitor Count and Circulation**

Visitor count for April 2018 totaled 18,035. This is decrease of 617 (-3.3%) visitors compared to March 2018 and a decrease of 575 (-.8%) comparing January – April 2017 to January – April 2018.

Circulation for April 2018 totaled 30,027 for all materials. This is a decrease of 3,465 (-11.7 %) in borrowing of materials compared to the previous month. Comparing all year-to-date checkouts through April, total circulation of library materials increased by 3,536 (2.9%). Because of changes in how Overdrive circulation is credited in the funding formula (by percentage of contribution), the circulation calculations are being totaled by library based on overall contribution to system-wide electronic materials.

The number of programs for April 2018 totaled 106 and attendees totaled 2,007. Comparing total program offerings and attendance data to the same time period for 2017 there is an overall increase of 48 (+11.9%) in total program offerings and an increase of 111 (+1.7%) in total program attendance.

In addition to our popular storytimes we hosted a local preschool for a library visit in April. The local Goddard school received a tour of our children's department and a storytime. We highlighted an interactive STEAM activities in our Rainy Day Art program for children ages 2-5. Children used inks and water to create various effects on different types of paper.

## Reference

We are happy to welcome Dominique Lewis & Laura Presby to the reference department. Dominique is a degreed librarian who also works in Montgomery County. Laura is finishing up her master's degree and also works at Chester County Library. Please be sure to stop by the reference desk to say hi on Mondays and/or Fridays.

The reference staff continue to make plans for programming, including an adult summer program that will mimic the switch from summer reading to summer quest. Patrons will be encouraged to visit culturally enriching sites, explore the databases offered by CCLS, and participate in more than just reading this summer.

Data collected for information assistance for April 2018 indicates a decrease of 239 (-9.5%) information transactions compared to March 2018 and a decrease of 44 (-2%) transactions compared to the same time period for 2017. PC use overall has decreased by 494 (-12%) compared to the previous month but increased by 197 (+6%) compared to the same time period for 2017. Information literacy classes (1 on 1 sessions) decreased by 8 (-16.3%) compared to the previous month but increased by 23 (+88.5%) compared to the same time period for 2017. Proctoring sessions decreased by 2 (-15.4%) compared to the same time period for 2017 while hours of proctoring offered increased by 7.25 (+46%) compared to the same time period for 2017.
