

Hand Sewing: Fleece Hat



Supplies:

Fleece approximately 16 inches high by 24 inches wide. One measurement must fit around your head.

Needle

Thread

Scissors

Optional: Tape

Measure

Skills:

Thread needle

Tie knot

Whip stitch

Cut thread/felt pieces



1. Thread your needle and tie a knot at the end.

2. Measure the circumference of your head.

Cut the length of your fabric to the size of your head plus 1 inch.

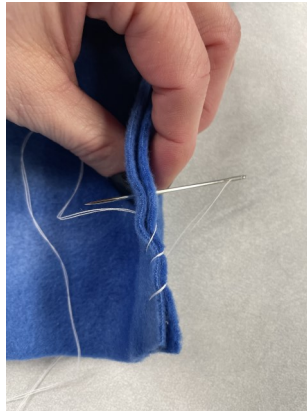


3. Fold your fleece in half.





4. Sew up the side of the fleece.



5. When complete turn inside out and test the fit.



6. Gather the material at the top and tie a knot. Leave room to cut a tassel.



7. Carefully cut the top piece of fabric to resemble tassel.



8. Enjoy your hat!



11. Pour the rice into the bottom of the sock.



12. Fill the sock with the stuffing.
Tie the top with the string.
You may want to cut some of the sock to make room for the hat that will rest on top.



13. Fit the hat on top of the gnome. Carefully glue or sew the hat to secure.



14. Glue the beard close to the edge of the hat. Then glue the nose on top on the beard against the edge of the hat.
Decorate as you like.
