

# Director's Report to the Library Board of Trustees March 25, 2021

The Libraries continue to mitigate operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic and are currently Tredyffrin Public Library is open for general access and computer use:

- Monday Thursday 1 pm 5 pm
- Friday 10 am 2 pm
- Saturday 10 am 2 pm
- CLOSED Sundays
- Curbside pickup hours are being adjusted based on anticipated staffing levels

Paoli Library remains closed to public access but continues to offer curbside pickup services:

- Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday 1pm 5 pm
- Friday 10 am 2 pm
- Saturday 10 am 2 pm
- CLOSED Sundays
- Curbside pickup days/times are being adjusted based on anticipated staffing levels

Both libraries are currently contacting furloughed staff to inquire about returning to work in anticipation of extending operating hours at both libraries. A number of furloughed staff have indicated that they will not be returning to work at the libraries. We are also currently posting part time positions in anticipation of having staff at the service desks in anticipation of increasing operating hours in April.

Currently, 5 out of 18 library buildings in the Chester County Library System remain closed to public access. All libraries continue to evaluate the risk of offering in-person library services and are adjusting access accordingly.

# **Building and Grounds**

- The Tredyffrin Public Library's first floor LED lighting replacement is almost complete.
- Tredyffrin Public Library's roof and HVAC have undergone a preliminary inspection for recommendations for repair or replacement of sections/components.

Since the Libraries were closed to public access for the month of February, no February data is included in this report.




Circulation





# **Programming Notes**

The libraries continue to develop virtual programs featuring synchronous and asynchronous programs and activities for people of all ages. Program statistics for 2021 are broken down by "regular" programs (on-site and via Zoom), by outreach, and by whether or not they qualify as a STEM program (to comply with state report statistical recording).

Through February 2021, the library recorded 537 programs and 8,090 attendees. Teen program statistics for 2021 were not available at the time this report was written.



# 2021 Read Woke with TTL Challenge

The 2021 Read Woke with TTL Challenge is open for all ages and will take place all year long. The goal of the 2021 Read Woke Challenge is to encourage readers of all ages to read diverse and inclusive books, to broaden their knowledge by reading books written by and about underrepresented and oppressed groups. As of March 10th, there are 45 adult participants. Additionally, a "Monthly Round Up" discussion group has formed for the adults. During the monthly discussion group, participants share their thoughts and discuss how each reader is approaching the year-long reading challenge.

A Spring Reading Challenge is currently being planned. The challenge will run from April 1st, 2021 through to May 31st, 2021. It will be offered on the libraries' Beanstack.

# **Virtual Adult Programs**

As of March 15th, Tredyffrin Township Libraries hosted a total of 14 adult virtual programs, including outreach, STEM, and passive programs, with 360 attendees. In March, so far, there were 3 one-on-one tech help sessions. In February 2021, Tredyffrin Public Library hosted a total of 27 adult virtual programs, including outreach, STEM, and passive programs with 492 attendees. In total, there were 12 one-on-one tech help sessions.

# YouTube Videos by Category

TTL video statistics, as retrieved from YouTube channel analytics, cover the "lifetime," or since time of upload, of the videos published. The Tredyffrin Township Libraries YouTube channel has a total of 244 subscribers, with an increase of 1 subscriber since February 20th.

#### **Book Talks**

As of March 15th, the Book Talks playlist received a total of 2,718 views for 26 unique book talks. There was an increase of 82 views since February 20th.

# **Virtual Technology Programs**

As of March 15th, the Virtual Technology Programs playlist on YouTube, received a total of 1,048 views for 20 unique videos. There was an increase of 49 views since February 20th.

# **Adult Virtual Programs**

As of March 15th, the Adult Virtual Programs playlist received a total of 1,737 views for 29 unique videos. There was an increase of 69 views since February 20th.
