Director's Report to the Library Board of Trustees January 27, 2022

The Libraries continue to mitigate operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic and are currently offering limited public access and curbside pickup hours.

Tredyffrin Public Library is open to the public:

Building and Grounds

Most of the building repairs from the pipe leak that occurred in September have been completed. A new heater was installed and due to fitment issues requires an enclosure to be constructed that fits behind the unit to cover some exposed piping and wiring.

The new phone system for the libraries is currently being installed.

HVAC P & M was completed and we are still waiting for an estimate for the King Room (Large Meeting Room) coolant leak.


The Township has completed the bidding process for the roof and HVAC work to be done at Tredyffrin Public Library. Hammel Associates Architects, LLC have begun preliminary assessment of the library roof and are comparing some measurements taken with the building plans from the last renovation. I've met with the Designer on the project for preliminary assessment and will be meeting again in the near future for more detailed inspection of the roof and to assist in developing a timeline for repair work. I will update the Library Board as I have more details.

Building Access

For the month of December, 7,279 library visits were recorded. Compared to last year, total visitor count has increased by 2,659 (+4%). There are no reasonable conclusions that can be drawn when comparing the door count this year to last year (due to changes hours of operations and varying pandemic mitigation efforts).






Circulation

Overall circulation increased compared to last year. Total circulation for the year remains lower than pre-pandemic totals. For 2021, 311,000 circulation transactions were recorded. This is an increase of 51.304 (+20%) compared to 2020. However, compared to 2019, this is a decrease of 72,793 (-23%).







In December, the Libraries offered 70 programs and recorded 852 attendees. Comparing program attendance to 2020, program offerings and program attendance have both decreased



Various Reading Challenges

The 2021 Read Woke with TTL Challenge concluded on December 31st with a total of 78 adult participants.

The Winter Reading Challenge began on December 1st. There is a total of 44 adult participants. The prize will be a \$25 gift card to Main Point Books.

Virtual Adult Programs

In December of 2021, Tredyffrin Township Libraries hosted a total of 29 virtual programs, including outreach programs, passive programs, and STEM programs. In total, there were 347 attendees. There were 8 one-on-one tech help sessions.

As of January 24th, Tredyffrin Township Libraries hosted a total of 28 programs, including outreach programs, passive programs, and STEM programs. In total, there were 334 attendees. There were 6 one-on-one tech help sessions.

2021 Program Totals

In 2021, there were a total of 418 programs, including outreach programs, passive programs, STEM programs, and one-on-one tech sessions. In total, there were 5,323 attendees.
