Director's Report to the Library Board of Trustees December 8, 2022

Operations

We are currently working with the Human Resources Director for Tredyffrin Township to review candidates for the Community Outreach and Adult Programs Librarian position at Tredyffrin Public Library. We also continue to experience turnover and continue hiring for part-time staff positions in order to increase operating hours at Tredyffrin Public Library.

Tredyffrin Public Library is open to the public:

Monday – Thursday 10 am – 7 pm

• Friday – Saturday 10 am – 5 pm

• Sunday 1 pm – 5pm

Paoli Library is currently open to the public:

Monday - Wednesday: 9:30 am – 5 pm

• Friday: 9:30 am – 5 pm

Saturday: 9:30 am – 5 pm

The Tredyffrin Township Board of Supervisors voted to approve the bids for replacement/repair work on Tredyffrin Public Library's roof and HVAC system. The request submitted to approve the bids is included at the end of this report.

The Friends of Tredyffrin Public Library have offered to redo the staff lounge with new equipment and furnishings. I've spoken with Kate Currigan regarding staff suggestions and have started marking furniture to discard. The Friends have also offered to bring in a company to clear out some additional old furniture and items in the basement along with the furniture from the staff lounge.

Capital requests for a new circulation desk, a book locker for book pickups, and some new shelving for the Children's Department are included in the Township's capital budget for 2023.

I'm currently working with the Head of Reference and Technology to reconfigure the floor space from the Circulation Desk to the teen area with new furnishings. We have received one quote and are awaiting a second to replace the bulk of tables and desk space in the area.

I've been meeting monthly with a member of the Public Works Department to address some building maintenance and upkeep needs.

Building Access

In working with the Township to clear out some unused equipment from Tredyffrin Public Library and the old security gates (the gates utilized magnetic strip technology as an anti-theft measure) that were non-operational and were removed. Unfortunately, the individuals assisting with removing the security gates believed the door counter was part of the security system to be removed and the door counter for the Children's Department door was accidentally removed and discarded. We discovered the mistake

after the equipment had already been discarded. Unfortunately, the door counters are no longer available for purchase. Chester County has a spare that they will install as soon as possible. For the November door count data, we had 15 days of recorded data. For the purpose of creating a fairly accurate representation of door count data, the remaining 15 days for November were duplicated using the data for the first 15 days.

For the month of November, 10,323 library visits were recorded. Compared to October, the visitor count decreased by 284. Comparing January – November totals for 2021 and 2022, the door count increased by 76.2%.




Programming Notes

In November, the libraries offered 62 programs and recorded 806 attendees. Programming totals for 2022 remain lower due to staffing changes and generally lower overall library visits.



SUBJECT: Tredyffrin Public Library Roof and HVAC Renovation

The Township is seeking authorization, from the Board of Supervisors to approve construction contracts for the renovations for the Tredyffrin Township Public Library. The renovations will replace the outdated and leaking roof and repair all damages on the interior caused by water damage. Relocation of HVAC units and provisions to provide heating and cooling during the construction process.

On October 26, 2022 at 9 AM, Tredyffrin Township received bids from qualified contractors for the Public Library Roof Renovations. The contract was broken into Two prime contracts. Five bids were received for the General/Site Contract, two bids were received for the Mechanical Contract.

The apparent low bidders are listed below:

- General/Site F.W. Houder Inc \$592,897.00
- Mechanical –Hirschberg Mechanical \$196,385.00
- TOTAL CONSTRUCTION BIDS \$789,282.00

Staff has reviewed all the bids for the Public Library Roof and HVAC Renovation Project. We are recommending approval of the bids as stated above.

The design, construction and construction inspection related work associated with this project, the proposed cost for the Public Library Roof and HVAC Renovation is allocated in the 2022 Township Budget and the 5-yr Capital Project Funding Plan. .
