

# January 2023 Branch Manager's Report


#### Personnel

#### Tax Preparation Assistance


The AARP Tax-Aide program, which offers free income tax assistance, is experiencing challenges with recruiting volunteer preparers, and unfortunately there will be no site in Paoli or Devon this year. Previously there was a site at the Paoli firehouse, with appointments scheduled by both the library and Rep. Melissa Shusterman's office. This year the nearest site will be at Easttown Library and demand will surely exceed supply.

Circulation
By the end of 2022, circulation had risen to 73% of December 2019 numbers.



### **Door Count**

The door count for December 2022 was 18% higher than in December 2021. At the beginning of 2022, the door count was 41% of pre-Covid (2019) numbers; it is now up to 62%.



## Fundraising

We are still not able to accept book donations due to a lack of space, but we continue to sell withdrawn books through our partner organization Mission Read. Our fourth quarter check from them was \$60.41.
