The program was a collaboration between Tredyffrin, Paoli and Easttown libraries and included many departments from all libraries. 150+ attendees on a very rainy day, and activities were moved indoors to the lobby, King Room (vendors), computer lab (crafts), story time and author reading downstairs. There were lots of social shares including thanks from vendors and attendees. Families expressed interest in more LGBTQ+ programming throughout the year, not just in June. The library is planning several events in 2024 including organizing a mingling time for solo vendors staffing their own table, larger location, and more partnering with county organizations. The Library will pursue continued collaboration with the vendor organizations.
