

Operations


Paoli Library is planning to reintroduce Sunday hours, as requested by the Tredyffrin Township Board of Supervisors. Sunday hours will be from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Currently, there is no set timeline; we are focusing on hiring and training staff to ensure consistent and reliable weekend coverage. To support weekend staffing, the township has approved the addition of two new circulation assistants. Interviews will be starting next week, and training for existing staff is underway.

Circulation

In February 2025, circulation of physical materials was 3,550, and circulation of e-materials was 1,775. The decline in physical checkouts could be attributed to the poor weather experienced in February 2025. We will be monitoring future checkout activity and anticipate an increase in circulation in the upcoming months.






